NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON ANNEXATION OF PROPERTY
FORSYTH CITY COUNCIL

Notice is hereby given that the Forsyth City Council will hold a PUBLIC HEARING on Monday November 8, 2021, at 7:00 p.m., in the Forsyth City Council Chambers at 247 North 9th Avenue, on the following agenda item:

On September 27, 2021, the City Council passed Resolution 2021-R13 of the City Council's intent to extend the city boundaries and annex real property known as 701 Willow Street, Forsyth, Montana, 59327 into city limits, as determined to be in the best interests of the City of Forsyth and the inhabitants of the property. For twenty (20) days following the first date of publication of this notice, written comments approving or disapproving the proposed extension of the city boundary will be accepted from registered voters residing in the area proposed to be annexed. The City Council anticipates taking action to annex the property into city limits as wholly surrounded property. Pursuant to § 7-2-4502, MCA, annexation of wholly surrounded property is not subject to vote. Community members are encouraged to attend the meeting to provide comments. If not able to attend, written comments are welcome and will be part of the public record.
